Dear Parents/ Guardians,

This year we are quite excited to be working with wonderful group of students. Their enthusiasm toward learning makes it a joy to work with. We have started our session with calendar activities and getting familiar with each children and their learning capacity.

A variety of different activities like Practical Life Exercises and Sensorial Preparation for Academic skills are being conducted for different age groups through the use of Montessori learning materials.

The cornerstone of Montessori education – “Normalizing Children” deals with teaching them how to do everyday activities necessary for their social, emotional and psychomotor development. This month we have focused on topics such as “how” and “where” to use classroom materials in a proper way, good manner and other calendar activities. Children need a lot of practice so that these activities can be accomplished therefore concentration on these activities at home would be very helpful for your child's learning.

English

This month the class focused on learning the phonic sounds of each letters from “A” to “G”. Worksheets with pictures of each sound and additional activities based on it also helped to strengthen their learning.

In Math, we have been focusing on number activities to strengthen their learning and this is further supported by other activities such as matching, encircling and sorting the objects (by colour, size and shapes), counting and writing etc.

Mathematics:

We have introduced geometrical shape with concepts such as “circle”, “big and small” and “same and different”. This month, we will learn the concept of “tall and short”, “more and less” and another geometrical shape- “triangle”.

Social Studies & Science

One of our uniqueness is that we develop our curriculum according to seasons in social studies and science. The children are learning names of month, days of the week, weather and seasons as they occur. We are introducing seasonal fruits and vegetables day by day to develop the concept of particular items through sensory perception such as observation, feeling, smelling, tasting etc. In class, we are exploring the primary colors – red, blue and yellow through various activities. As you can see, many activities are current on-going in the kindergarten class. We encourage you to visit the classroom observe your child at work and play.
