
GRADE 7

English:

Grade seven students have finished 'Unsung Hero' an interview with Miep Gies who had helped Anne Frank's family during the time of holocaust. Through this story they learned a lot about the Second World War and the totalitarian Nazi rule in Europe. They watched a holocaust based movie too and wrote their movie review as well. Moreover, they have learned about the usage of sentence connectors. The next lesson for grade 7 students is 'Sympathy', a poem by Paul Laurence Dunbar.

Science:

Mathematics:
