English Department:

As you know the first term has come to an end, I am pleased to report that this term has been particularly busy; with a lot of integration program in the beginning followed by a great deal of learning and sharing.

My grateful thanks go to all students who have supported my bid to finish the course in time and I hope they are able to continue their cooperation in the months ahead.

A very enjoyable Spelling Bee took place during the end of the term. The contest saw four teams compete with Deanna Sherpa being declared the best speller of grade six.

The first terminal examinations will take place from 6th August – 14th August. If you have any queries, please feel free to share with us.

Mathematics Department:

Grade six students have completed the addition and subtraction of algebraic expressions and multiplication of algebraic expressions will be taught in the second term. The units covered for the first terminal examination are sets, whole number, lines, angles and addition & subtraction of algebraic expressions. The first terminal Mathematics examination has 20% practical questions of half an hour and 80% theoretical questions of two hours.

Social Studies Department:

Grade six students have done a research work on the origin and development of society in groups and have presented it in the classroom. They have identified social problems and evils practiced in the child's community and have suggested solutions to overcome those problems. They also discussed the causes and consequences of those social problems and evils. These topics are included in the syllabus for first term examination:

Unit One: We, our community and Nation

Unit Two: Our Infrastructures of development

Unit Three: Our Social tradition social values and norms

Unit Four: Social Problems and Evils

Science Department:

Students of grade six have completed the unit of measurement, force, density and its measurement in Physics, matter and solution in Chemistry, living beings (Plant Life and Animal Life) in Biology, and the earth in Geology for the first term.

EPH Department:

Grade six students have successfully completed their unit tests. Their curriculum for the first term examination has been completed. These topics are included in the syllabus for first terminal examination:

- Introduction and importance of population and environment
- Situation of natural resources, cultural heritage and population
- Population change and causes of environmental degradation
- Human body
- Nutrition
- Environmental health
- Personal health and hygiene

Computer Science Department:

Grade six students have completed the unit of number system and Microsoft word for the first term. I regret to inform you that the unit 'Computer and Computer System' has been forwarded for the second term owing to time constrain.

Visual Art Department:

Sixth graders were taught collage painting for this term. They exhibited active participation in Mural Art Project and were also involved in decorating chart papers for the Teachers' Day Celebration.

Music Department:

The following areas have been covered in Music during the first term.
