### English Department:

As you know the first term has come to an end, I am pleased to report that this term has been particularly busy; with a lot of integration program in the beginning followed by a great deal of learning and sharing.

A very enjoyable spelling bee took place during the end of the term. The contest saw four teams compete with Anmol Shakya being declared the best speller of grade eight. ### Mathematics Department:

Grade eight students have completed classification of the polynomials, multiplication and division of algebraic expressions. The remaining portion of the unit algebraic expressions will be taught for the second terminal examination. The units covered for the first terminal examination are sets, line and line segments, angles, integers, polygons, solids, classification of polynomials and division of algebraic expressions. The first terminal Mathematics examination has 20% practical questions of half an hour and 80% theoretical questions of two hours.

### Social Studies Department:

Grade eight students have actively participated in round table discussion with various religious scholars on the topic religious tolerance in Nepal. They have studied about various social traditions. They have observed and analyzed a documentary '*Ragat Sabai Ko Auatai Hunchha*' of Musahar community of Siraha district with which the children related it to the burning issue of social inequality. Students have explored the social problems and evils practised in our society and have suggested solutions to solve problems. They have also analyzed the role of social organization to control those social problems and evils. The Syllabus for first term examination is as follows.

Unit One: We, our community and Nation

Unit Two: Our Infrastructures of development

Unit Three: Our Social tradition social values and norms

Unit Four: Social problems and Evils

**Science Department:**

Grade eight students have completed the unit of measurement, motion, and machine in Physics; matter, acid-base and Salt in Chemistry; living Beings (Major plants and animals of Nepal), life cycle of a plant, and classification of plants and animals in Biology for the first term. The unit of Pressure and The Earth has been forwarded for the second term.

**EPH Department:**

Grade eight students have successfully completed their unit tests. Their curriculum for the first term examination has been completed. These topics are included in the syllabus for first terminal examination:

1. Introduction and importance of population and environment
2. Situation of natural resources, cultural heritage and population
3. Population change and causes of environmental degradation
4. Human body
5. Nutrition
6. Environmental health
7. Personal health and hygiene

**Computer Science Department:**

Grade Eight students have completed the unit of Number System and Programming language & Computer software for the first term. I regret to inform you that the unit 'Programming in Q-BASIC' has been forwarded for the second term due to time constrain

**Visual Art Department:**

Eighth graders were taught collage painting for this term. They exhibited active participation in Mural Art Project and were also involved in making greeting cards. As a regular part of the curriculum children paid a visit to Neer Bhawan and Nepal Art Council to see an art exhibition.
