

## NEWS FROM GRADE ONE

We are very happy to inform you about our monthly newsletters. This is the first newsletter of grade one and you will be getting such a newsletter every month throughout the year. As a grade one teachers' team we strongly believe that parents should keep themselves updated with the on-going activities in the classroom. You are heartily welcome to visit your child's classroom to make the grade one learning experience a memorable and enriching one.

In English the first grade students are involved with story telling in multiple forms like reading picture books, chapter books, telling stories in the oral tradition. Children are participating in whole, small groups, and individual discussions initiated by the teachers. They have been learning the opposite words, this and these, that and those, days of the week and names of colours. They have been introduced with the use of before, in between and after orally.

In Social Studies the unit 'Child and child's family' will be continued for the next few weeks. In this unit children have learnt about their forename and surname, age and their body parts. Students were also taken on a field trip to the airport. The objective of the field trip was to give first hand knowledge about the helicopter and the aeroplane.



In mathematics the first grade students have learnt to draw, recognize and discriminate the straight and curved lines. They have also acquired knowledge about different geometrical shapes like square, rectangle, triangle, circle, oval and star. And they have been working in drawing the geometrical shapes and this will continue for the next few weeks.

In Science children have been learning about living and non-living things through different project works like collecting living and non-living things from the school playground, pasting them in A4 paper, collecting different pictures of living and non-living and pasting them in their notebook. They have been introduced with the characteristics of living and non-living things through oral discussions.

Children are learning computer handling process. Now they can log on to their computer and at the end of this unit, they will be able to log on, log off and shut down their computers.
