English Department:

This newsletter provides a flavour of what students have been doing during the last few days. The new session commenced with first few classes dedicated to integration activities whereby the students got to know each other better.

Sixth graders have finished the first unit “Arthur and the Sword”. The story is about King Arthur and his mythical sword, sometimes attributed with magical powers or associated with the rightful sovereignty of Great Britain. A story about a sword which chooses its own master. Students worked in groups to review timelines and presented the story in different forms. They were engaged in activities that force them to think about and comment on the information presented. Likewise the students worked on the poem “Wind- Wolves” by William D Sargent. In this poem the poet chooses wolves for the wind and deer for the clouds, developing the idea that wind chases the clouds just as wolves might chase deer.

We missed quiet a lot this past week hence the units that we are currently doing are “Brighter Still” and “Packing for a Picnic”. Last but not the least we also encourage parents to talk about these stories and the books with their children.

Mathematics

This month we are mainly focusing on “Arithmetic” in lower secondary level. The students of grade six have done the unit “Sets” and are doing project work on square numbers. They have prepared charts on the unit “Whole numbers”.

Science

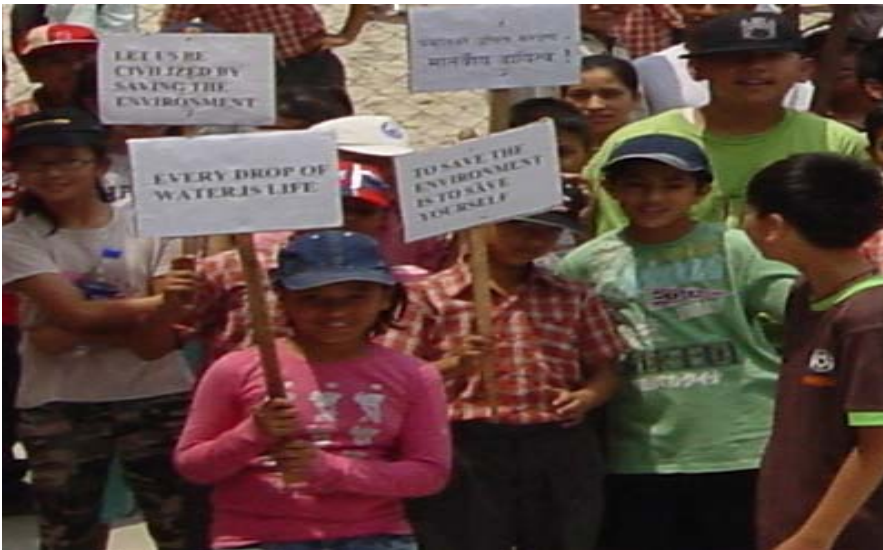
Children have studied the unit of measurement and force and understood their importance in our daily life. They made the models of measuring instruments commonly used in our daily life. Presently they are studying the unit of density.

Social studies

Grade six students have learnt about Introduction to Community, Village Development Committee, Municipality and some other development activities in their Community. They selected the Chairperson and deputy Chairperson of Village Development Committee by electoral process in the classroom. They explored the importance of Community Services .Beside this, students have researched the development works of Village Development Committee and Municipality. The project work of the each group has been displayed in the classroom.

Environment and population Education:

Grade six students have learnt the introduction and importance of population and environment. Though this subject is new to them, they have shown good interest on this subject. They have drawn beautiful pictures of their surrounding environment and presented in the classroom. They have started becoming aware of the present situation of our natural environment. They watched a documentary on 'GAINEKIRA' and listened to environmental song 'MA HU PRAKRITI'. They celebrated the 'WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY' on June 5th. They have successfully completed first unit assessment. In the upcoming weeks students will learn about Human Body and Situation of natural resources, cultural heritage and population.



Computer:

Children are studying the unit of Number System. In this unit they have studied numbers and number system, base of the number systems and types of number system. They understood importance of studying different types of number system in computer.
