This is the second monthly news letter of grade one. And we are happy to inform you about your child and about the progress in class. We have already mentioned earlier that parents should keep themselves updated with the ongoing activities in class, and we were happy to see parents coming in to meet us for the same purpose.

In English the first grade children were introduced to the concept “isn’t”. They have also been introduced to common preposition. (E.g. in, on, under, outside, inside). To enhance their vocabulary the grade one children have been introduced to new words in the form of story telling. There have also completed their season booklet using A4 size paper, colour paper, making snow man with cotton, cutting pasting etc thus making their learning experience more exciting. To enhance the children listening skill the children are doing a question /answering session in class once a week. To improve the writing skills the children write in four line copies forming simple sentences. They have also been introduced to “composition” “myself” through oral discussion.

In Science children have been learning about plant. To make their learning experience more exciting the children went on a “plant hunt” in the school playground. They have been learning about “parts of plants”, and through oral discussion the children have been learning about the function of the parts of plant. The children have enjoyed collecting leaves to learn that there are different shapes and sizes of leaves found in our surrounding.

In Mathematic ,the first grade student have learnt about numbers, number name , smallest numeral ,greatest numeral, increasing order ,decreasing order, after, between, before ,bigger than and smaller than up to 10.They have been doing ordinal numbers up to 10 and the unit “number concept” will be continued for the next few weeks followed by addition and subtraction.

In Social studies students have been working, with the unit “child and child’s family”. In this unit, they learnt about five sense organs, their functions and students good habit. The unit will be continued for the week followed by another unit “Nepalese traditions”
