We are maintaining a good pace with the completion of 4th story '**The Hole**' and beginning of 5th called '**The Golden Bird**' in English. The students are actively involved in class discussion, class work, home assignments, worksheets assignments, quiz, project works and so on. They reviewed the story both in oral and written form which was really appreciable. During this period in particular, the students got to experience and practice individual oral project presentation which was solely prepared and managed by the students themselves under teacher's supervision.

In **Science**, through field trip the students have refined their knowledge on different aspects of animal kingdom like types of animals & their body type, their food habit, their classification according to habitat, their seasonality and their advantage to human beings. Similarly, post trip activities such as class work, home assignments, worksheet, project work etc also helped them to broaden their horizon in this subject. The student's collection of different seasonal animals was excellent. Currently the students are focusing in '**The Plant World**' and we hope the coming science classes to be very interesting.

Social studies proceeded with its usual fun and experience centric approach where they were assigned a couple of project works on civic sense which was successfully completed, submitted and a class presentation was done. The subject matter covered was the study of notice, traffic rules and symbols and reasons to follow them. The class even simulated a heavy traffic scene showing people following traffic rules and understanding the traffic symbols as well as the consequences of not doing so as to provide student with more concrete knowledge on the subject. We also prepared our class family tree which is now displayed in the classroom. The highlight of social studies this month was '**Ashar 15**'. The students had a first hand experience of paddy planting procedure.

Mathematics is full of practical games that help students to be clearer about number concept, addition, subtraction etc. We have finished the unit "**Number concept**" and now we are introducing '**Addition and Subtraction**' with the help of base ten blocks, cards and tooth picks.
