English Department

This edition of the newsletter gives you a picture of the progress that the students and the teacher together made after a few days of loss in regular class activities. Grade six children have read and analyzed the stories 'Brighter Still and 'Packing for a Picnic'. Brighter Still is based on a theme of how an example of love for its kind and sacrifice can help to change human cruelty. Here in this story an innocent deer is easily able to change the mind of a hunting maniac with the gesture of love and sacrifice for its kind.

Packing for a Picnic is an excerpt from the book 'Three Men in a Boat'. In this excerpt, the author describes how he and his friends went about packing for a trip. It is a humorous account. 'Stop Thief 'by Charles Dickens is another lesson that the children enjoyed acting out thoroughly. Children were enthusiastic enough to get costumes from home to stage the play in the classroom in groups. As Parents you could help your child improve their language and understanding by providing them with novels and storybooks that they find interesting.

Social studies Department:

Grade six students have learned about the 'Infrastructures of Development' available in child's community. They delivered speech in the classroom on the 'Importance of Education in Our Life'. Students have done a research projects about Situation of Education and Health Service in their Community and compared it with one of the village of remote district like Rukum.

Students have studied and analyzed the contribution of a healthy citizen for the development of a community. They have compared the system of transportation and communication of now and then. Grade six presented the current situation of electricity and drinking water in their community through their project work. Students have identified the problems of generating electricity and distributing drinking water in their community.

On the auspicious occasion of 15th Ashar students took part in the paddy plantation program in the field and cultural program at school. This time the students are studying 'Our traditions, social values and norms'.

Mathematics Department

Grade six students have completed the unit '**Whole number**'. They have learnt to distribute the equal amount of things or an object to maximum number of people. Presently they are studying the unit '**Lines & Angles**'.

Science Department:

Students of grade six have completed the unit of density in Physics, Matter in Chemistry and Plant and Animal Life in Biology. They conducted a small experiment on chemistry to study the properties of matter on the unit 'matter'. The unit of plant and animal life was completed through class presentations by students followed by the class discussions. They collected the pictures of various plants and animals for their presentation. They have conducted a research project on 'Life cycle of rice Plant' and 'Carbohydrate' for Asar Pandra Celebration.

Environment, Population and Health Department:

Grade six students have completed the units of "Situation of natural resources, cultural heritage and population", "Population change and causes of environmental degradation", "Human body" and "Nutrition" and also did group presentation, project work and chart work on the relevant topics. Students are more confident while doing presentation and have started sharing their outstanding views regarding environmental issues. Other supplementary reading materials were reviewed for those units. We are going to form an Eco Club involving the students of grade six onward. In the upcoming weeks students will learn about "Environmental health" and "Personal health and hygiene".

Computer:

Grade Six students have studied the unit of Number System. During this month they have understood the following types of conversions and binary operations.

Conversions:

- a. Decimal to binary, octal and hexadecimal
- b. Binary to decimal

Binary Operations:

- a. Binary Addition
- b. Binary Subtraction

Presently, they are learning Microsoft-Word. In this unit they have learnt file handling process.
