English:

In English they have completed all the structures of this term. Children are now learning to make simple sentences and even to write a paragraph of at least three sentences.

Science:

In science they have already completed the second unit “Personal Hygiene” of this term.

They are going through the last unit “Environment/ Environment Cleanliness” of this term. In which they are learning different measures to keep their surroundings clean.

Mathematics:

In mathematics they completed the unit “Weight” and “Addition”. They have learnt to add two digit numbers without carry over. They are now learning “Subtraction”

Social Studies:

In Social Studies they have already completed the first unit “Child and Child’s Family” They are going through the last unit “History”. In this unit they have learnt to give a brief background of their family members.

Computer

They practiced the shape tools and the options related to it. They learned to make the shape only with the outline, outline with fill, and only fill. They learned to apply these tools to make greeting cards with outline and patterns as well as text.

Visual Arts

Visual Arts conducted lessons in different forms of Drawing and Painting during the month.

Students enjoyed playing with different mediums and creating their ideas in their projects. Junior Kids developed 2D drawings, Acrylic painting, Paper masche and pre work on clay with dough. Secondary level students also developed 2D drawings with 3D effect, Impression drawing, Imaginary drawing and practiced to develop pattern design. Sixth graders got a chance to visit an art exhibition.
