English:

Students completed the third unit “**The King of the Golden River**” and they have already started with Unit IV. They presented the first story in different ways like story wheel, story necklace and story cloud. Unit test of the second and third units has already been taken. The unit report will be sent to you after the unit test. Students dramatized the second story “**The Letter Box**”. Besides vocabulary and critical discussions of story issues, they have learned Nouns, Verb and Articles and are working in **Punctuation**. We have already focused on identifying homophones and working out the difference between words in homophone pairs. As mentioned before, we are constantly emphasizing on spoken and written language quality as well as importance of neatness in work and presentable handwriting. We will update you with the course content we have finished so far for the first term and the changes we’ve brought in the First Term curriculum for some subjects.

Science:

We are about to finish the lessons for the First Term and at present the children are presenting the project work On Natural Disaster. Unit test of the chapter will be taken this week.

Mathematics:

In mathematics, grade four students are working on division. After completing this topic, they will do some simplify based on four operations.

Social Studies:

For this term social studies acquaints students with a new unit on social problem, modification and solution. They students were quiet familiar with the problems existing in society. They are presently engaged in collecting newspaper cuttings and pictures depicting social problems. The motive for encouraging students to do so is to enable them to analyze social problems by themselves. In up-coming events, grade four will have short field trips interviewing people involved in different social organizations. They have already done the Unit Test of the second Unit and the report cards will be sent to very shortly.
