English:

Grade six children have read and analyzed the story 'Packing for a Picnic'. Packing for a Picnic is an excerpt from the book 'Three Men in a Boat'. In this excerpt, the author describes how he and his friends went about packing for a trip. It is a humorous account.

At present the children are engaged in the lessons 'Stop Thief 'by Charles Dickens and 'Marion to The Rescue' by Paul Berna with presentations on PowerPoint and similar activities based on these lessons.

Hence, with the first term almost coming to an end, so far we have completed the activities based on the five stories and one poems of the Gul Mohar Text. Students need to revise all the work done in the units for thorough preparation of the First Term Exam.

Science:

Children have studied the unit of living beings and The Earth. After completion of the unit of living beings, the students were able to classify different types of plants and animals on the basis of their habit and habitat. They completed the unit on Pressure and learned why the objects sinks or floats (depending upon density).

Mathematics:

Grade six students have completed the unit set and presently they are doing the unit 'Whole numbers'. They learn about square, cubic and pattern of the numbers. Presently they are doing prime and composite numbers. The units covered for the first terminal examination are sets, whole number, lines, angles, polygons and solid.

Social Studies:

Grade six students have learned how to respect and honor the people of different castes, color, gender and profession without discrimination. They explored the religious traditions, and festivals, which are observed in child's community. They have completed the research project on preparing the biography of a person whose contribution is highly valued in child's community/country and presented in the classroom. Students have studied about the religious tolerance and its significance in our community. A unit assessment was taken and feedback was given to the students in order to increase their level of understanding. Now they are exploring Social Problems and Evils practiced in child's community.

Computer

Grade six students have studied Binary Arithmetic. In Binary Arithmetic, they have learnt to perform binary addition and binary subtraction. Presently, they are studying the unit Operating System. Following units have been taught during this term.

The unit “Computer and Computer System” has been forwarded to the second term due to time constraint.

Students made cards with messages on population and distributed them to school staff. Some students interviewed school staff to know their family size and their family planning.
