

## GRADE 7

### नेपाली

### English:

Since the publication of the last newsletter grade seven students have completed the story *What Happened to the Reptiles* by Zai Whitaker, a story about a jungle full of reptiles. The story was a good read for the students and moreover they enjoyed reading the character of Makara who is presented as a dictator in the story. Students are all ready for their First Term Exam. The kids have learned about passive voice and active voice and their usage in written English.

### Science:

Students of grade seven have completed the unit of living beings and The Earth. They also had class discussions and class presentations while completing the unit of living beings. They prepared the model of Earth showing different layers of Earth as their project work on unit of The Earth.

### Mathematics:

Grade seven students have completed the unit Whole Number and presently they are doing addition and subtraction of algebraic expressions. The units covered for the first terminal examination are sets, whole number, lines and angles and taught part of the algebraic expressions.

### Social Studies:

Grade seven students have studied about our traditions, social values and norms. Students were taken on a field trip to National Ethnographic Museum and final project is displayed in the classroom. They discussed and analyzed the role of an individual and community to abolish the caste and gender discrimination practiced in our country. They evaluated the changing pattern of celebrating the festivals in Nepal. They have discussed about the development of democratic system in Nepal and critically analyzed its merits and demerits.

### Computer

Grade seven students have studied Binary Arithmetic. In Binary Arithmetic, they have learnt binary addition, binary subtraction and binary multiplication.

Presently, they are learning Microsoft Excel. Following units have been taught during this term.

The unit Introduction to Computer has been forwarded to second term due to time constraint.

### EPH

This is the third newsletter. Students marked July 11 as 19th Annual World Population Day, 2008. The theme of this year is "Plan your future and plan your family". Students made cards with messages on population and distributed them to school staff. Some students interviewed school staff to know their family size and their family planning. They prepared report based on the interview. Students became aware of rapidly growing population.
