English:

Grade Eight students have completed two lessons *A Poison Tree* a poem by William Blake and *Bound Feet* by Jung Chang, an autobiographical story about the situation of women in china. The poem had lots of metaphors as most of Blake's poems usually have and it was a good treat to the students. Students later came up with their own metaphorical poems which will be put together in the form of an anthology. Students have learned about the rules of subject verb agreement. Students are all set for their first term exam.

Science:

Students of grade eight have completed the unit of living beings and The Earth. They also had class discussions and class presentations while completing these units. They were really excited to make a model of volcano while completing the unit of The Earth.

Mathematics:

Grade eight students have completed the unit 'Sets'. Presently grade eight students are doing multiplication and division of algebraic expressions. The units covered for the first terminal examinations are sets, integers, solid, lines and angles and taught part of the algebraic expressions.

Social Studies:

Grade eight students have completed unit three Our Traditions, Social Values and Norms. They identified and explained the social traditions, and religious tolerance. They have completed a research project on the present situation of national heritages in Nepal and presented in the classroom. Students have suggested the Department of Archeology to preserve, protect and promote these heritages. A guest speaker (Mr Som Paneru) was invited and presented a lesson on importance of social organization for the development of our country. A unit assessment was taken and feedback was given to the students in order to increase their level of understanding.

Computer

Grade eight students are studying the unit Database Management System. In this unit, they have understood the basic concept of database and database management system. Besides this, they are learning to use different features related to database in Microsoft Access. Following units have been taught during this term.
