नेपाली

नेपाली विषयमा कक्षा तीनका विद्यार्थीहरूलाई कथा विधाबाट 'अनौठो परीक्षा' र संवाद विधाबाट 'हाटबजार' शीर्षकका पाठ अन्तरगतका क्रियाकलापहरू गराइएका छन्। उनीहरूलाई पढाइएका पाठहरूका कठिन शब्दहरू वाक्यमा प्रयोग गर्ने, समूहगत योजना कार्य अन्तरगत पढाइएको कथाहरूलाई संक्षेपमा लेखी कथा माला, कथा वादल बनाउने कार्य र कुनै शीर्षकमा कुराकानी (संवाद) गर्ने कार्य गराइएको छ।

English:

'The Hole', 'The Golden Bird' and 'Robot in the Garden' are the three chapters from the English book that is being covered this month. Each of these chapters emphasize on different grammatical aspects - gerunds, articles, present perfect tense, and adverbs. Worksheets on different topics as well as written work in notebooks are being done. Creative writing such as making sentences, writing paragraphs and doing book reviews are a huge part of their English lessons. The weekly library class encourages reading at home. From the grammar book exercises on nouns have been completed and work on pronouns, adjectives, etc. are also being done. All the classes are being carried out in such a way that every lesson contributes to the children's spoken and written English. And also, to increase their vocabulary, and understanding of the English language

Science:

In Science, we have completed the units about the characteristics of living things followed by the unit 'Plants'. Now, they are learning about animals and it will be continued for a couple of weeks followed by the unit 'Environment'.

Mathematics:

In Mathematics, two units 'Time' and 'Money' have been covered so far. We have started the measurement unit and it will be continued for a few more weeks.

Social Studies:

In Social Studies, we rounded up last months 'Good Habits' with a project work. Good habits while eating, and in the bathroom, and how to properly wash hands, and 'Respect and Attitude' were the main topics. This month geographical aspects of the subject are being covered - how to look at a map; how to locate places in a map or globe; the continents; the oceans; the equator; the hemispheres, etc. This is in continuance of their grade two classes on directions - north, south, east, and west. A unit test will also be carried out this month. All the classes are being carried out with much emphasis on their relevance to one's surroundings and its importance in everyday life.



Computer

Grade 3 learned to add text to their picture by using text tool. They were taught to open color pallet and mix colors in it. They even changed text color, text size, text type.

Visual Arts

Department of art and craft took on drawing, painting with all the students. Students are learning to develop and sharpen their creative skills through the practice of drawing and painting using different mediums. They prepared some key drawings and developed them into large size canvases and papers.

Students from grade 4,5 and 6 participated in a day art workshop on the occasion of World's Environment Day, 5th June 2008 "KICK THE HABBIT"
