English:

The students completed the second unit "The snow Goose" and they have already started with Unit III. They presented the first story in different ways like story wheel, story necklace and story cloud. Unit test of the second and third units will be taken on 9th of July. The unit report will be sent to you after the unit test. Students dramatized the second story "The Snow Goose" and all the students were part of the drama and the pictorial presentation of the story has been done. The students have finished with story wheel on a new story "The King of the Golden River" and are actively working on character sketch. Besides vocabulary and critical discussions of story issues, children have enjoyed learning Nouns, Verb and Articles. We have also focused a great deal on identifying homophones and working out the difference between words in homophone pairs. We are constantly emphasizing on spoken and written language quality as well as importance of neatness in work and presentable handwriting.

Science:

With the completion of the animal kingdom and the study plant kingdom, the children made animal booklets for their science project work. Shortly they will be taken to field trip for the study of plants. The study of plant development is going on in the classroom through daily observation of pea plant planted in the pot by the students. At the moment third unit "Natural Disasters" is going on. Now they are working on the post trip activities for their science project work.

Mathematics:

Students are learning basic operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division) in mathematics. They can solve addition and subtraction problems with the use of base ten blocks. Right now, students are working on multiplication and division. We have focused on everyday drill of multiplication tables for about 10

minutes. Students enjoy the challenge of this simple but important activity we carry out each day.

Social Studies:

The children finished Unit I “**Me My Family and Neighbors**” They also made pictures of “**Me and My Tools**” for their project work. The unit test of this unit has already been taken. The report Card of this test will be sent to you very soon. They are about to finish Unit II “**Our Social Traditions, Norms and Values**” In up-coming events, grade four will have short field trips interviewing people involved in social organization and also to Kathmandu Municipality. They took active participation in paddy plantation on the occasion of Pandra Asar. They are integrating themselves with the importance of social norms and our traditions by class discussion and role plays

Computer

In grade 4 the children did lot of typing practice in notepad. They have understood to move the cursor between the lines and edit typed paragraph. Besides this they learned to save their file in the desired folder.

With this they are now ready to start with WordPad, where they will learn to change the font color, size and type of their text.

Visual Arts

Department of art and craft took on drawing, painting with all the students. Students are learning to develop and sharpen their creative skills through the practice of drawing and painting using different mediums. They prepared some key drawings and developed them into large size canvases and papers.
