English:

Grade six students have finished the story 'Brighter Still', a moralistic tale which regards sacrifice as the highest mercy. Though the story was an old one, students enjoyed it to the utmost. The class had a good debate about the moral of the story; some students were against it whereas others supported it. At present, the class is doing 'Packing for Picnic' by Jerome K. Jerome. As for structure students have learned about the usage of linking words like nevertheless and however. They have also finished the usage of 'either ...or' and 'neither.... nor' in sentence.

Science:

Children have studied the unit of matter and mixture. The unit of matter and mixture was completed by conducting experiments. They were really excited to carry out the experiment to know the properties of matter on unit matter and method of separation of mixture on unit mixture. They have also completed the unit of living beings in biology. Presently they are studying the unit of The Earth.

Mathematics:

Grade six students have completed the classification of triangles according to its side and angle from the unit 'Polygons'. Presently they are studying the unit 'Sets'

Social Studies:

Grade six students have learned about the infrastructures of development like education, health service, transportation, communication, electricity and drinking water available in student's own community. They have critically analyzed the present situation and the necessity of those factors for sustainable development in a community. They have completed a research project on relationship between transportation, communication and electricity as infrastructures of development. On the occasion of 15th Asar, students participated in paddy plantation program and reviewed the program. They watched and later analyzed a documentary called "In The Name of Tradition". A unit assessment was taken and report has

been sent to the parents. Now they are studying about “our tradition, social values and Norms”.

Computer

Grade six students are studying the unit Number System. In this unit , they have learnt the following types of conversion.

- a. Decimal to Binary and vice-versa
- b. Decimal to octal and vice-versa

Presently, they are learning to solve simple problems on Binary addition and Binary subtraction.

TOWARDS A LOW CARBON ECONOMY**".
