English

Grade seven students have finished stories 'Maggie Cuts Her Hair' by George Eliot and 'What Happened to the Reptiles' by Zai Whitaker. Both stories were good read and students learned a lot from these stories. Students also learned the usage of 'may and might'. Students are yet to do their project work on these stories.

Science:

Students of grade seven have completed the unit of matter and mixture. The unit of mixture was completed by conducting experiments. They were really excited to carry out the experiment to know the method of separation of mixture on unit mixture. In biology, they have also completed the unit of Living Beings. They had class discussions and class presentations while completing this unit. Presently they are studying the unit on The Earth.

Social Studies:

Grade seven students have studied about the infrastructures of development like education, health service, transportation, communication, electricity and drinking water available in district and zone. They discussed on the needs and the present situation of education and the health service in one's district and zone. On the occasion of 15th Asar, students participated in paddy plantation program and had a lively discussion on its significance in the classroom. They have completed a research project on relationship between communication and transportation and presented it in the classroom. They have analyzed the role and effort of local government in providing the basic needs of development. Now, they are reading Our Traditions, Social values and Norms

Mathematics:

Grade seven students have completed the unit 'Lines & Angles' of geometry. Presently they are studying the 'Whole numbers' of arithmetic.

Computer

Grade seven students are studying the unit Number System. In this unit they have studied different types of conversion such as decimal to binary & vice-

versa, decimal to octal & vice-versa and decimal to hexadecimal and vice-versa. Presently, they are learning other types of conversion and binary operations.

This is the second newsletter. Students celebrated the world environment day on June 5, 2008 with different environmental activities. The slogan of this year's environmental day is "**KICK THE HABIT! TOWARDS A LOW CARBON ECONOMY**".
