English:

Grade Eight students have finished two lessons 'The Fun They Had' and 'Three Questions' by Leo Tolstoy. 'The Fun They Had' was a good science fiction by Isaac Asimov which the students enjoyed most. The best part of doing the story was when students brought their own sci-fi stories for their project work. In structure they have finished tense and restrictive clause and non- restrictive clause. Students will soon start 'A Poison Tree' a poem by the famous English poet William Blake.

Science:

Students of grade eight have completed the unit of simple machine, matter and acid, base and salt. They conducted different experiments while completing the unit of acid, base and salt and understood the use of litmus paper as an indicator. Presently they are preparing their presentation as a group work to complete the unit of Living beings.

Mathematics:

Grade eight students have completed the unit 'Polygons' and 'Integers'. Presently grade eight students are doing the unit 'Sets'.

Social Studies:

Grade eight students have learned the infrastructures of development like education, health service, transportation, communication electricity and drinking water and human resource. They have completed a research project on different factors of development and presented it in the classroom. On the occasion of 15th Asar students participated in paddy plantation program. A panel discussion was organized in order to signify the socio-cultural importance of this festival. Students watched documentaries *In the Name of Tradition*, *Chaupadi* and *Gadhimai Mela* and critically analyzed the strengths and weaknesses of the documentaries. Grade eight students have studied the unit Number System. During this month they learnt the followings in this unit.

- e. Binary subtraction
- f. Binary multiplication
- g. Binary division
