English:

English Language

Students of grade nine have started unit 4. In this unit, they have learned about the writing process of condolence letter and sympathy note. Also, they have learned about the writing process of news report. Students are doing their project work on the same. Students learned to convey condolence and sympathy in conversational English. Soon, grade nine will start unit 5.

Optional English

Students have done two poems in this period; 'Written in March' by William Wordsworth and 'When I Was One-And –Twenty' by A.E. Houseman. Moreover, they have also finished an essay on Madam Curie and a play 'The Right Person' by Donn Byrne. Soon they will start the story The Widow of Ephesus by Petronius.

Science:

Grade nine students have studied the unit of Valency and chemical reactions and learned how to balance a chemical equation. They have also completed the unit of classification of plants and animals through class presentations followed by group discussions and the unit of life cycle of some insects. Students were excited to know the life cycle of mosquito and silkworm. Presently they are studying the unit of Simple machine.

Mathematics:

Grade nine students have completed the unit 'Triangles'. Presently grade nine students are doing the unit 'Algebra'.

Optional mathematics

In the beginning of the month the chapter related to function was continued and by linking with algebra the new chapter about surds was stated. The discussion about additions of surds and their subtraction were done and rationalization of radical signs was introduced. In the last some equations about surds were introduced.

Social Studies:

This month, the focus was mainly on the pillars of development – education, health, electricity, transport, communication and water resource. Class discussion along with critical analysis worksheets reinforced their comprehension of the importance of the development infrastructure to the nation.

Grade 9 practiced web page designing .Topics taught:
